KNOX CLUB SOCIAL GOLF CLUB CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP RULES

*** TO BE ELIGIBLE TO PLAY IN THE CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS, YOU NEED TO BE A FINANCIAL MEMBER, AND HAVE A CURRENT KNOX CLUB HANDICAP PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE CHAMPIONSHIPS.**

For the purpose of the Championships, a member qualifies for his/her club handicap once he/she has put in 3 individual qualifying handicap cards (not 'Ambrose' games) during the previous 12 months, either by playing as a visitor, or after becoming a financial member.

*** YOU ALSO NEED TO HAVE PLAYED, (3) THREE GAMES FROM THE END OF THE PREVIOUS CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS.**

*** THE CHAMPIONSHIP HAS THREE (3) GRADES**

- (A) GRADE 0-20
- (B) GRADE 21-30
- (C) GRADE 31-45

*** THE GRADE YOU START IN IS THE GRADE YOU FINISH IN.**

*** YOU CAN BE HANDICAPPED ON ALL GAMES PLAYED DURING THE CHAMPIONSHIPS, SO YOUR HANDICAP CAN GO UP OR DOWN DEPENDING ON YOUR SCORE.**

*** YOU ALWAYS PLAY TO YOUR HANDICAP OF THE DAY.**

*** THE CHAMPIONSHIPS ARE PLAYED IN FEBRUARY, MARCH & APRIL ON DIFFERENT COURSES**

*** STROKE IS TO BE PLAYED IN THE THREE (3) ROUNDS OF THE CHAMPIONSHIPS.**

*** THE FORMAT TO DETERMINE THE CLUB CHAMPIONS IS THE BEST TWO (2) OUT OF THREE (3) NETT SCORES IN RELATION TO PAR (ie. strokes under par in respect to the Course Rating shown on the card – eg. 7 under), AS OPPOSED TO THE ACTUAL NETT STROKE SCORE (eg. Nett 72).**

*** YOU CAN HAVE MORE THAN ONE (1) WINNER IN EVERY GRADE.**

*** NO PLAY OFF'S OR COUNTBACKS.**
